As much of the country is continuing to grapple with COVID-19, we want to give you insight to our business and steps that we have taken for you, our valued customers. As a family business and your neighbor, Sweet Betsy Farm is committed to keeping both you, our customer, and ourselves healthy.

Sweet Betsy Farm is following the CDC's guidelines on washing hands, social distancing and sanitizing. We have closed our store building and stopped hive tours due to the inability to social distance and opened a self serve honor system stand for honey and egg sales. This is a no-contact outside stand which is open daily from 10-6. All surfaces are cleaned periodically throughout the day. The Farm Market Stand, open seasonally on Tuesdays and Saturdays, will offer online pre-sales with delivery directly to your vehicle. Our team will be wearing face masks and we ask that you do the same. We reserve the right to refuse service if our team members do not feel safe.
